Next week is our Harvest Thanksgiving Sunday

Our special Harvest offering this year is going to **Feed the Hungry** - a Christian charity providing hot nourishing meals to daily needy & marginalised people, especially children, in 20+ countries worldwide.

By the gift of food they are empowering the local church (pastors & leaders) to meet the basic needs in their communities; the hunger for food, the hunger for learning through schools & development etc.

We have chosen two projects to support—

1) Flooding in NEPAL – an urgent appeal In August, torrential rains hit that country & 24 million people have been affected. Over 800 have lost their lives. Our partners like Pastor Ruben Rasaili are there who are able to reach those in the most remote needy places.

Please pray that food & support supplies will get through for those most in need.

2) Refugees fleeing into UGANDA In late 2013 civil conflict began in South Sudan with people escaping over the border into Uganda. This is still continuing Over 2,000 people flee S.Sudan into Uganda **every day** (as of March 2017). 90% are women and children.

Please pray for Pastor Solomon Mwesige who organises our work in Uganda and the 46,000 children we currently feed in camps there.

It's a fact, a full life feels good! And because of that, it is so satisfying to know that when we give to FTH, we do more than just give food. Through nourishing meals, education for their future & the opportunity to know Jesus, we give thousands of the world's hungriest kids the chance to live a full life.
