** Praise God for:

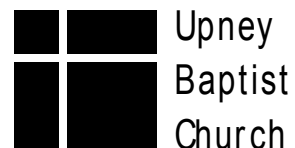
- opportunities to share the Good News of the Gospel and strengthen relationships with the Youth, on an outing to hear preaching in Alba Lulia.
