In the MIDDLE EAST They are helping needy displaced Iraqi Christian children overcome the darkness of war.

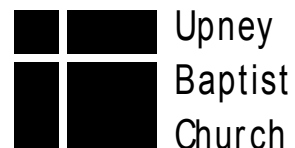
