* Pray for people facing homelessness for the first time, that they would find practical help for their immediate and medium-term needs, and help with addressing some of the related issues that have contributed to their present situation.

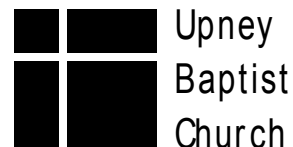
## NEWS from MARK & EVE YOUNG
