The centre is closing as a night shelter is being constructed (at Webber Street.) The shelter will house 6 homeless people (at a time) for 6 months, with the aim of helping them find permanent accommodation and work etc.

Pray for LCM as they set this up and look to recruit staff, volunteers etc.
