* We are continuing with the children's activity twice a month on Saturday afternoons (helping children & teens with school work and Bible Club)

For Prayer: That new children & teens will come and join us - up till now no new ones have been participating Our aim is to reach new children from the neighbourhood.

* The ladies' meeting is monthly. This is a good opportunity to reach new women.

* Visitation is quite difficult nowadays to do door-to-door evangelism. People are wary of opening their doors because of insecurity & also because other groups use the same method & are unwelcome. So instead we sometimes speak to people passing by in the street. Pray for the tracts that are distributed. We are very grateful for those we receive from the Gospel Printing Mission.

* Please pray for Gaston. You'll remember he asked for baptism at the end of 2018, and then decided to stop doing the course. He hasn't been in church for several months now. His wife & two girls have started to come again.
